Questions 4 and 5 are based on the case study presented below. Read the case carefully and answer both questions.

Madison High School is located in the village of Mount Young. The school has a population of 946 female students ranging in age from 12 to 18 years. The principal was concerned about two main issues affecting the school population:

- Issue 1. The growing rate of teenage pregnancy at Madison High
- Issue 2. The small number of girls returning to school after giving birth, even though school policy allowed them to do so

The principal contracted the local university to conduct a survey on the two issues.

The sample consisted of 125 students who had dropped out of school, over the last four years, as a result of pregnancy. With regard to Issue 1, the survey revealed that 50 students were unaware of where to obtain free contraceptives and 75 were not exposed to appropriate sex education programmes.

In relation to Issue 2, 30 students were unaware that they could return to school, 25 had no interest in continuing education, 50 did not have adequate childcare support and 20 could not financially afford to return to school.

The findings were presented to the principal and staff, and recommendations were made based on the findings.




(c) On the grid provided below, use a bar graph to display the number of respondents who supplied each reason given in the table.
