#### The Decline of Fishing Activities in the Village of Freeton

Freeton is a small fishing village located on the coast of the island of Elgan. Freeton has a population of 1800 residents, the majority of whom depend on fishing for a livelihood. In recent years, however, residents' income from fishing has been greatly reduced and many of them are unable to support their families.

A research company was contracted by the Ministry of Agriculture to conduct a survey among the residents of Freeton to get their opinion on what they thought was contributing to the decline in fishing in the village.

The research company asked 120 fisherfolk to complete questionnaires. The data revealed that 40 per cent thought that competition from the new fishing village nearby was the cause; 35 per cent said it was the cheaper cost of imported fish; 20 per cent believed that the cost of maintaining the fishing boats was the problem and 5 per cent stated that the younger persons in the village were not interested in fishing.

The findings were documented and presented to the Ministry of Agriculture.


